



Mandarin Chinese Teacher Needed (full-time)

The Rochester City School District has received funding from the U.S. Department of Education to begin a new foreign language program that will give students from Nathaniel Rochester Community School No. 3, the opportunity to learn Mandarin Chinese.

In addition to basic literacy skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing), much of the instruction will center around thematic units that will focus on embedding linguistic and cultural aspects of China. These units will engage students in activities in which they must think critically, and provide opportunities for students to use the target language in meaningful contexts.
